Australian Wood Duck, *Chenonetta jubata* (Latham 1801), Vagrant (8)
1910 Lake Glendhu, (= Glendu Bay, Lake Wanaka) Otago

One was shot at “L. Glendhu”, Wanaka in 1910 (Marples 1944). This apparently refers to Glendhu Bay, Lake Wanaka, 10 km west of Wanaka. The second was shot “about the middle of 1944 near Invercargill” in the Orawia district, Southland. Both of these specimens are in the Otago Museum.

There is a gap in sightings until records at Wairau River, Marlborough, April 1980; Snares Island, December 1982 - March 1986; Otapiri, Winton, Southland, May 2002; Mt. Cook, February 2005; Hokitika SP, January 2007 & Christchurch February 2009.
